CLINICAL EXPERIENCE:

Over the years, my experience has expanded to include various areas in the field of obstetrics and gynaecology :

- **Obstetric experience:**

I have been involved in the antenatal care of both low and high-risk pregnancies. I was also responsible for running the Day-Care Assessment Unit, assessing and managing high-risk cases such as pregnancies associated with hypertension, IUGR and diabetes mellitus.

I have performed instrumental deliveries including forceps and ventouse deliveries. I have performed caesarean sections for all indications including those for placenta praevia and for the preterm babies.

- **Gynaecological experience:**

I have managed both acute and chronic gynaecological cases . I have been involved in colposcopy as well as urogynaecology clinics.

I have performed diagnostic and operative laparoscopies. I have performed all the minor as well as most of the major gynaecological operations including vaginal repairs, abdominal and vaginal hysterectomies as well as abdominal slings.

- **Special experience:**

My special interest is management of the labour ward. At El-Galaa Teaching Maternity Hospital (20000 deliveries/year), I am in charge of the labour

ward, supervising junior doctors and teaching them the art of obstetrics. I am also responsible for revising the labour ward protocols. I have achieved a high competence level in managing antepartum, intrapartum as well as postpartum complications of all kinds.

TRAINING EXPERIENCE:

At El-Galaa Teaching Maternity Hospital, I am involved in teaching medical students, junior doctors as well as Egyptian Fellowship candidates. Teaching includes theoretical lectures and clinical training, mainly in the field of obstetrics.

I am also involved in organizing the maternal and perinatal morbidity and mortality meetings as well as the journal club meetings.

My scope of work as a clinical supervisor with the Healthy Mother/Healthy Child Project (JSI) included the design and implementation of training programs based on the results of the situation analysis and training needs assessment. I also assisted in conducting training of trainers (TOT) courses as well as on job training for the health providers in many hospitals all over Egypt. Moreover, I have been one of the key persons responsible for reviewing and updating the labor ward protocols for the Ministry of Health and Population.

MANAGEMENT EXPERIENCE:

I have been responsible for planning a 5-year project for complete renovation of El-Galaa Hospital including the redesign of the infrastructure and the purchasement of the new equipment.

I am also a member of the quality improvement team at the hospital.

Moreover, being the head of the emergency Obs./Gyn. Department, I carry the responsibility for running this department regarding both the administrative and clinical issues.

I am also a member of the hospital accreditation team in the Ministry of Health and Population responsible for accrediting hospitals all over Egypt.
